

CATTLEMEN'S JACKPOT SHOW 2012 RULES

GENERAL ENTRY RULES

1. Classes are open to all junior exhibitors 5 through 19 (21 for heifer show) years of age. (Age as of January 1, 2012). Juniors Age 5-8 are not eligible for CJLA points
2. The entry fee will be \$40.00 per head. Entry fee doubles if payment not received by entry deadline.
3. The entry deadline is Friday, February 25, 2012. Entries postmarked after that date will be considered late and the double entry fee penalty applicable.
4. There will be **no** refunds on entries.
5. All exhibitors must show their own animals, except when more than one entry is exhibited at one time. In this case, another exhibitor may help.
6. Any exception to the entry rules must be approved by the Show Committee. The Show Committee reserves the right to make any changes or exceptions necessary for the betterment of the Jackpot Show. All committee decisions are final.
7. Uniforms of any youth group (4H, FFA, Grange) are not required.
8. **New** Entry in Showmanship is mandatory; entry fee is \$5. Showmanship contestants must show in the Jackpot show. Fitting is not required in showmanship classes.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to the ring on time.

STEER JACKPOT RULES

1. Steers will be classified as follows:

ENGLISH: Must be purebred Angus, Shorthorn or Hereford.

New In accordance with CJLA rules, **Registration Certificates are required and must be checked in the office prior to weighing.**

ALL OTHER COLOR - for all breeds or crossbreeds which are predominantly red, white, or any other non-black color.

BLACK - for all breeds or crossbreeds which are black in color or have **any** black marking.

ANY QUESTION about the proper color classification for a steer will be settled at weigh-in by the Jackpot Committee.

2. Each steer must be entered in the name of a specific exhibitor.
3. Classes will be broken by weight. Divisions will be as follows:

PROSPECT STEERS - UNDER 900 POUNDS

PROSPECT ENGLISH

PROSPECT ALL OTHER COLOR

PROSPECT BLACK

GRAND CHAMP & RESERVE PROSPECT STEER

PROGRESS STEERS - 900 POUNDS AND OVER

PROGRESS ENGLISH

PROGRESS ALL OTHER COLOR

PROGRESS BLACK

GRAND CHAMP & RESERVE PROGRESS STEER

FEMALE SHOW JACKPOT RULES

REGISTERED HEIFERS

1. Open to heifers born from 9/1/2009 through 10/31/11. Classes will be broken by age according to entries.
2. Heifers that have already calved may show both in the heifer class as well as the cow/calf pair class. (Counts as 2 entries with 2 entry fees)
3. Cow/Calf pairs open to lactating cows with natural calves at side; the calf must be under 8 months old.
4. All heifers must be registered in the name of the exhibitor. ORIGINAL PAPERS MUST BE PRESENTED AT CHECK-IN. NO EXCEPTIONS! Tattoos may be checked.
5. Entries must meet Breed Association's standard for that particular breed.
6. Breed divisions will be: Angus, Hereford, All Other Breeds and 2 other breeds to be determined at entry close. Cow/Calf Pairs of all breeds will show together.
7. BRED AND OWNED CLASS: No entry fee. Awards will be given to Champion and Reserve. Bred & Owned classes will follow each breed division. Check the "B&O" box on the entry form to enter.

New MARKET HEIFERS

1. Market Heifer classes will be broken by weight
2. Market Heifers must be weighed by 8 AM Saturday morning.
3. Market Heifer Champions are not eligible to compete for Supreme Champion.

BARN RULES

STALLS: There are no pre-assigned stalls. Exhibitors may choose their own tie area on a first come-first served basis. Due to limitations of space, animals are only allowed **one** place to tie. None of our covered pens are to be used for "tie-outs".

BEDDING: Bedding will be shavings. Exhibitors will be required to clean their tie area before leaving. **NO STRAW WILL BE ALLOWED!**

BLOCKING CHUTES: No blocking chutes will be allowed in the barn where cattle are tied. Special areas will be designated for blocking chutes. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

BARBECUES: No barbecues will be allowed in the barns.

GENERATORS: No generators will be allowed in the barns. They must be located **OUTSIDE.**
